## **Truro Loops – Phase 1**

### **Walking and Cycling Improvements on the Newham Trail and Connections to the City Centre**

Cormac Solutions Ltd on behalf of Cornwall Council is inviting comments on a proposal to provide walking and cycling Improvements to the Newham Trail and connections to the Truro City Centre.

#### **Newham Trail**

The improvements to the Newham Trail are shown on this set of 10 drawings:

The improvements include:

- An improved surface to the trail
- Improved signage
- A new access to the trail (near New County Hall)
- Repairs to Penwethers bridge
- Installation of a guardrail at Arch Hill bridge
- Rockfall prevention / protection measures
- Benches and picnic tables
- Gas Hill carpark surface improvements
- Parking restrictions on Gas Hill (No waiting at any time)
- Street lighting on Gas Hill and Gas Hill car park



- Improved road crossing points

## City Centre Connections

The improvements to the City Centre Connections are shown on drawings:

ENG1691\_SN\_01 – shows improved road crossings and signage on Newham Road and Gas Hill

ENG1691\_SN\_02 – shows a change of restrictions at Frances Street to allow entry by cycles as well as buses

ENG1691\_SN\_03 – shows the installation of a pedestrian refuge on Station Road

ENG1691\_SN\_04 – shows an improved road crossing point at the junction of Bosvigo Road with Richmond Hill

ENG1691\_SN\_05 – shows improved crossing points on George Street and Richmond Hill and parking restrictions on George Street

ENG1691\_SN\_07 – shows improved crossing points on Castle Street and Little Castle Street and junction improvements

ENG1691\_SN\_08 – shows sign amendments and cycle stands at Lemon Quay

ENG1691\_SN\_09 – shows cycle stands at Victoria Square

ENG1691\_SN\_10 – shows an additional pair of cycle stands at Truro railway station
